Why participate?

- Provide a verified record of true outcomes in consecutive unselected ex situ liver surgery cases.
- Help identify relevant, modifiable predicting factors for outcome after ex situ liver surgery.
- Become part of an international research network.
- Access anonymized raw data for spinoff studies, upon approval by the scientific committee.
- Obtain PubMed citable co-authorship and access the raw data for future studies.

How can you get involved?

- Form a team of up to 3 colleagues at your institution. Participants may include surgeons, anesthesiologists, hepatologists, or other members involved in ex situ liver surgery.
- Obtain necessary local approvals, if required. Note that this project may be approved as an Audit in the UK, as a Quality Improvement Program in the US, and may not require formal ethics approval.

Both retrospective and prospective case submission is accepted.
